
Sometime in mid-1991, I was contacted by Bob and Nancy Ralston to testify in the trial of their daughter, Amy Ralston-Pofahl, who I have known since birth. Amy's trial attorney did not contact, interview, or meet with me to ascertain any information that might be helpful to Amy's defense. He had absolutely no knowledge of what I could or could not say on the stand. I felt sure when I arrived that he would brief me on any information I might have. Instead, I was ushered directly into the court room to testify. I was completely ill-prepared. He began a line of questioning which was quite beneficial to the prosecution. I really wanted to say that I knew Amy and that she was of good character. I do not recall this ever being mentioned.

In the course of my career, I have never witnessed an attorney with such bizarre behavior as he exhibited. I distinctly had the impression that he wanted to quickly dispose of the case and leave the court room.

When the prosecution cross examined me, the defense attorney constantly looked over his shoulder and seemed totally distanced from what was happening in the court room.
